About the College

The Baldeo Sahu Mahavidyala, also known as the B. S. College, was founded on 15th August, 1962 to commemorate the 16th anniversary of India's independence. The college received provisional affiliation from Ranchi University on April 23, 1963 and permanent affiliation on April 26, 1968. The college started offering honours courses in Economics, History, Sanskrit and Urdu from the academic session of 1969-70. The college also introduced the Faculty of Science in the next session. In 1977, the college became a constituent unit of the university. The honours courses in Botany, Chemistry, Mathematics, Physics and Zoology were launched in the year 2009. The PG courses started with the six subjects of Economics, Hindi, History, Pol. Science and Kurukh in 2018, and subsequently added Nagpuri in 2019.

About the Conference

With a population of approximately 3.50 Cr. Jharkhand contributes close to 4 lakh crore in GDP of India. For centuries Jharkhand has remained away from mainstream Indian society. This fact has both pros and cons. The state has rich culture and traditions on the one hand but lacks behind in education and development. ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

The abstract should be approximately 300 words and must summarize the main ideas, objectives, result and conclusion of the paper. It should also include 5-6 keywords relevant to the research. The abstract must clearly mention the details of the researcher like affiliation and contact details.

FULL PAPER SUBMISSION

After the acceptance of abstracts, full papers must be submitted before the given deadline. The full paper should be approximately 3000 words and must be original and free from plagiarism. The paper should be written in Times New Roman font with a font size of 12 and space 1.5 for the main text.

MEDIUM OF PAPER SUBMISSION AND PRESENTATION

The research paper can be written either in Hindi or in English. The presentation can be bilingual in nature.

सभी सारांश और पूर्ण शोध पत्र नीचे दिए गए ईमेल आईडी पर Word file और PDF जमा किए जाने चाहिए:

सारांश लगभग 300 शब्दों का होना चाहिए और इसमें शोध पत्र के मुख्य विचारों, उद्देश्यों, परिणामों और निष्कर्षों का सारांश होना चाहिए। इसमें शोध से संबंधित 5-6 कीवर्ड भी शामिल होने चाहिए। सारांश में शोधकर्ता के विवरण जैसे कि संस्थान, संपर्क विवरण आदि का स्पष्ट उल्लेख होना चाहिए।

सारांश की स्वीकृति के बाद, पूर्ण शोध पत्र निर्धारित समय सीमा से पहले जमा करने होंगे। पूर्ण शोध पत्र लगभग 2500 शब्दों का होना चाहिए और मूल होना चाहिए तथा लेखकीय चोरी से मुक्त होना चाहिए। अंग्रेजी शोध पत्र टाइम्स न्यू रोमन फॉन्ट में लिखा जाना चाहिए, जिसका फॉन्ट साइज़ 12 होना चाहिए और 1.5 स्पेस होना चाहिए। और हिंदी शोध पत्र यूनिकोड अथवा क्रुतिदेव फॉन्ट में लिखा होना चाहिए।

शोध पत्र हिंदी या अंग्रेजी में लिखा जा सकता है। प्रस्तुति द्विभाषी प्रकृति की हो सकती है।
